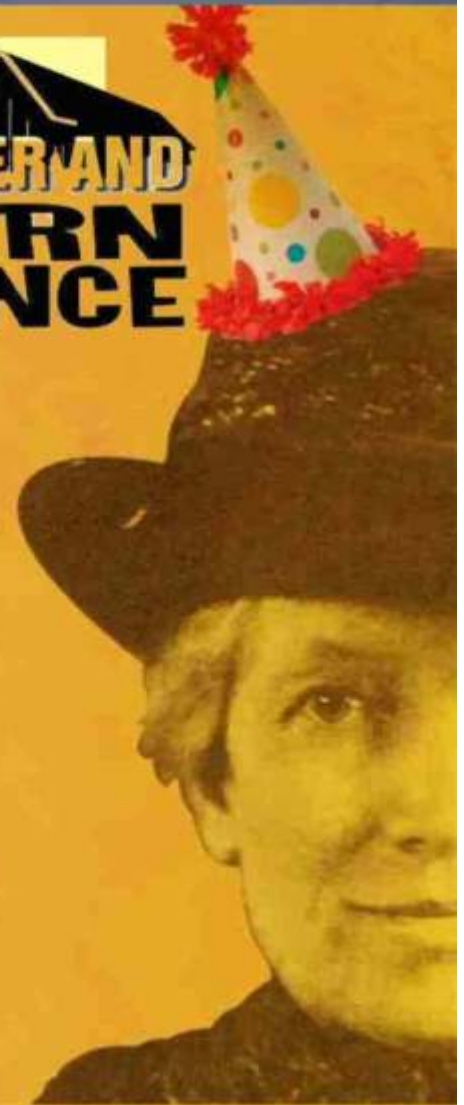

The township of Westbank was laid out in 1900, and the name for our town was suggested by John Davidson, a ship's carpenter from Glasgow, Scotland. 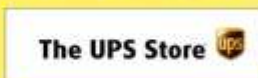
